

Cull Family Memorial Scholarship

CRITERIA ELIGIBILITY

I **Religious Vocation:**

- A. If the high school graduate is an alumnus of St. Mary's School, North Vernon, Indiana,
- B. Has been accepted by and (arch) diocese or by a religious order to pursue becoming a religious sister, religious brother or priest, then
- C. That person must receive a scholarship.

II **Lay Applications:**

- A. If the graduating senior attended St. Mary's School, North Vernon, Indiana, and
- B. That person can be proven to be a presently attending Mass and a faithful member of the Catholic Church (if different, the Catholic Church which they now attend will be contacted to verify their present status) and
- C. That person intends to remain a faithful member of the Catholic Church, then
- D. That person is eligible to receive a scholarship.

III **Academic Standing:**

- A. The senior high school applicant should have a GPA of C or better.
- B. The student must present proof of matriculation into a college, university, or technical school before receiving scholarship.

IV Each applicant must fulfill the requirements as listed above and complete each section of the application including the essay, according to the time frame given.
